

## ACEL Fellows Receive Top Honours

ACEL Fellows have received awards of excellence at the 2014 WA Education Awards.

Ray Boyd was named Primary Leader of the Year for transforming West Beechboro Primary school's academic results from "under performing" to above average, and for lifting its standing in the community and students' behaviour.

Jacqui Quartermaine is principal of Rangeway Primary School in Geraldton. Rangeway PS is the first school to be awarded the new WA Premier's Excellence in Aboriginal Education Award.
