Criteria for selection:

- An aspiring educational leader

- Currently completing or recently completed (in the past 5 years) a Master of Education or Doctorate in Education
- Demonstrated excellence in educational leadership research
- Demonstrated capacity as a forward-thinking, relevant and responsive educator

CATEGORY 3: The 'New Indigenous Voice' in Educational Leadership

This scholarship recognises impressive new indigenous voices in educational leadership, with a total of four of these scholarships available nationally.

Criteria for selection:

- An aspiring educational leader
- Teaching qualifications
- Currently employed in an educational institution in Australia
- Of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Demonstrated excellence in current educational role
- Demonstrated capacity as a forward-thinking, relevant and responsive educator

CATEGORY 4: The 'New Voice' in Early Education and Care

This scholarship recognises an impressive 'new voice' in early education and care from each state and territory of Australia. Presented by ACEL and ACECQA.

Criteria for selection:

- An aspiring educational leader
- Teaching qualifications
- Currently employed in an educational institution in the state/territory
- Demonstrated excellence in current educational role
- Demonstrated capacity as a forward-thinking, relevant and responsive educator
